FlightWorks Adds Ten Aircraft in Past 10 Months

Fleet Grows in Diversity, Range and Features

KENNESAW, GA – September 10, 2007. FlightWorks, the nation's leading general aviation company, has added ten aircraft in the past 10 months, bringing the company's fleet offerings to over 30 diverse aircraft.

Additions include a Challenger 601, Gulfstream G200, Hawker 800A, Citation VI, Citation Ultra, Beechjet 400, King Air 350, and a Pilatus PC-12. The company also added a Gulfstream III and a Citation Sovereign in late 2006.

"By having a diverse fleet, we're able to offer our clients efficient travel options that match their requirements, with all the comforts of executive travel," said Scott Beale, president of FlightWorks. "Our primary goals of safety and top-drawer client service are always top of mind and these new aircraft provide more choices for our clients."

Aircraft added since late 2006 include:

- Challenger 601: N190MP – With a cruising speed of 528 miles per hour and a maximum range of 3,889 statute miles, this Southeastern-based Challenger 601-3R has a spacious cabin that seats nine and has sleeping accommodations for two people. Pull-out tables for workspace, fine catering and entertainment provide the ultimate of comfort in the stand-up cabin. It flies at a maximum altitude of 38,100 feet.

- Gulfstream G200: N164GA -- Serving the Southeast from its base in Savannah, GA, this brand new Gulfstream G200 is one of only a few of this in-demand super-mid-size aircraft available for charter in the United States. The spacious stand-up cabin offers seating for up to 10 passengers in plush, fully-adjustable seats and a first-class entertainment system. The G200 has an impressive range of 3602 statute miles, a cruising speed of 528 miles per hours and a full service mini galley, plus plenty of room for baggage in both internal and external compartments.
- Hawker 800A: N24JG – Furnished with leather captain chairs and a 3-person forward couch, this Mid-Atlantic-based, mid-size aircraft has a maximum range of 2,750 statute miles at a cruising speed of 475 miles per hour. The cabin is versatile with fully adjustable seats for a group conference and pull-out writing desks/dining tables. It has a cruising altitude of 41,000 feet.
- Cessna Citation VI – Based in the Mid-Atlantic, this Citation VI has business-class seating for seven in leather club chairs and executive writing/dining tables. Comparable to the Citation III, this mid-size jet has a cruising speed of 491 miles per hours and a range of 2,037 statute miles at an altitude of 43,000 feet.
- Citation Ultra – This light jet's impressive speed capabilities of 460 miles per hour and comfortable cabin make multiple stops an easy way to maximize your workday. The Citation Ultra is Southeast-based at KRYYY, McCollum Field where it provides regional service with a full array of amenities for comfort, convenience and style.
- Beechjet 400: N913MC – Designed for quick trips across the country with a range of 1,312 statute miles, this Southeast-based Beechjet cruises at 514 miles per hour at 40,750 feet. This light jet can accommodate up to seven passengers and has pull-out desks for room to work.
- King Air 350:N800BJ – Based in the Southeast, this King Air 350 has executive seating for eight in soft leather captain chairs equipped with executive writing desks and a DVD/CD system with flat screen monitors. It cruises at a maximum speed of 359 miles per hour and has an impressive range of 2031 statute miles. This turbo prop flies at a maximum altitude of 35,000 feet.
- Pilatus PC-12: N78PG – With seating for six in leather captain chairs and executive writing tables, this single-engine Pilatus PC-12 turboprop can take off and land on the shortest runways and is extremely fuel-efficient. It has a cruising speed of 311 miles per hour, 1,688 statute-mile range and a maximum altitude of 30,000 feet.

- Gulfstream III: N109DD – This large executive aircraft based in the Southeast seats 12 in leather captain chairs and can accommodate sleeping for four passengers. With a cruising speed of 550 miles per hour and a range of 3,982 statute miles, this long-range Gulfstream jet is suitable for traveling across the country or abroad. It can cruises at an altitude up to 43,000 feet.
- Citation Sovereign: N202DF – Serving the Mid-Atlantic from its base in Manassas, VA, this 2006 Sovereign is one of only a few of this in demand super mid-sized aircraft available for charter in the United States. The spacious stand-up cabin offers seating for up to nine passengers I leather captains chairs and a first-class entertainment system. The Sovereign can take off from runways as short as 3600 feet, has a range of 3042 statute miles at a maximum cruising speed of 528 miles per hour.
