### FlightWorks Announces Participation for 2006 Citation Special Olympics Airlift

FlightWorks to Assist in Flying More Than 2,500 Special Olympic Athletes and Coaches to Iowa for the 2006 National Games

**ATLANTA** (February 13, 2006) FlightWorks, a leading provider of private aviation solutions and services, will use one of their fleet's Cessna Citation business jets to assist in the transportation of more than 2,500 Special Olympic athletes and coaches to the Special Olympics USA National Games, to be held in Ames, Iowa, from 2-7 July 2006.

The Citation Special Olympics Airlift, which was created in 1987, is the largest peacetime airlift in the world. This summer's airlift will be the largest Citation airlift ever. FlightWorks is joining other corporations and individual Citation jet owners and operators who donate their Citation business jet(s), pilots and fuel to transport athletes and coaches to the National Games. The FlightWorks Citation will depart for the Des Moines International Airport on July 1, 2006. After the conclusion of the USA National Games, the FlightWorks Citation will return to Iowa on July 8 to pick up the Georgia-based athletes and return them to Atlanta.

Bruce Pasternack, President and CEO of Special Olympics applauds FlightWorks and other Cessna Citation aircraft owners for providing this wonderful service and experience to our Special Olympic athletes. "FlightWorks is a leader in business aviation and their participation only makes our airlift stronger," said Pasternack.

The first Citation Special Olympics Airlift took place in 1987 and involved more than 130 Citations that carried almost 1,000 athletes to the Special Olympics World Summer Games in South Bend, Indiana. In 1991, 200 Citations took nearly 1,500 athletes to and from the World Summer Games in St. Paul/Minneapolis, Minnesota. In 1995, 215 Citations transported 1,600 athletes to Hartford, Connecticut. In 1999, 275 Citations donated by 260 individuals and companies transported more than 2,000 Special Olympic athletes and coaches to and from Raleigh-Durham, North Carolina.
