Aircraft added in the first six months of 2007 include:

- Challenger 601: N190MP – With a cruising speed of 528 miles per hour and a maximum range of 3,889 statute miles, this Southeastern-based Challenger 601-3R has a spacious cabin that seats nine and has sleeping accommodations for two people. Pull-out tables for workspace, fine catering and entertainment provide the ultimate of comfort in the stand-up cabin. It flies at a maximum altitude of 38,100 feet.
- Hawker 800A: N24JG – Furnished with leather captain chairs and a 3-person forward couch, this Mid-Atlantic-based mid-size aircraft has a maximum range of 2,750 statute miles and a maximum cruising speed of 475 miles per hour. The cabin is versatile with fully adjustable seats for a group conference and pull-out writing desks/dining tables. It has a cruising altitude of 41,000 feet.
- Beechjet 400: N913MC – Designed for quick trips across the country with a range of 1,312 statute miles, this Southeast-based Beechjet cruises at 514 miles per hour at 40,750 feet. This light jet can accommodate up to seven passengers and has pull-out desks for room to work.
