FLIGHTWORKS ADDS THREE NEW AIRCRAFT IN FOURTH QUARTER OF 2006
Fleet Grows in Diversity, Range and Features

KENNESAW, GA – December 2006. FlightWorks, one of the nation's leading general aviation companies, has added three new aircraft in fourth quarter of the year. Additions include a [Citation Sovereign: N202DF](#); a [Pilatus PC-12: N78PG](#); and a [Gulfstream III: N109DD](#).

"By increasing our range and the choices for private air travel, we can better serve our clients and meet the ever-increasing demand for general aviation. Aircraft added in the fourth quarter of 2006 include:

- Citation Sovereign N202DF -- Serving the Mid-Atlantic from its base in Manassas, Va., this 2006 Sovereign is one of only a few of this in-demand super-mid-size aircraft available for charter in the United States. The spacious stand-up cabin offers seating for up to 9 passengers in leather captains chairs and a first-class entertainment system. The Sovereign can take off from runways as short as 3,600 feet, has a range of 3,042 statute miles and a maximum cruising speed of 528 miles per hour.
- Pilatus PC-12: N78PG – With seating for six in leather captain chairs and executive writing tables, this single-engine Pilatus PC-12 turboprop can take off and land on the shortest runways and is extremely fuel-efficient. It has a cruising speed of 311 miles per hour, 1,688 statute-mile range and a maximum altitude of 30,000 feet.

- Gulfstream III: N109DD – This large executive aircraft based in the Southeast seats 12 in leather captain chairs and couches. The Gulfstream III can accommodate sleeping for four passengers. With a cruising speed of 550 miles per hour and a range of 3,982 statute miles, this long-range Gulfstream jet is suitable for traveling across the country or abroad. It can cruise at altitudes up to 43,000 feet.
